Training tyre fitters



Mobile skill training vans fitted with state-of-the-art tyre fitting equipment would be plying on the highways and transport hubs in Tamil Nadu and would train tyre mechanics. A mobile skill van was flagged off by KM Mammen, chairman, Automotive Tyre Manufacturers' Association (ATMA) and CMD of MRF Tyres in the presence of executive director of Rubber Board KN Raghavan recently. The vans have been launched by Rubber Skill Development Council (RSDC) under the project Saamarth, which aims at re-skilling a million people in rubber as mandated by Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship. In Tamil Nadu, the mobile vans will up-skill 3000 tyre mechanics and certify them during the month of March 2020.
